## 2 Introduction

This document contains the release notes for Datafarm VUE v1.1. The following sections describe the release in detail and provide late-breaking or other information that supplements the main documentation.

## 3 What's New

- The order of documents displayed in the cumulative view has been improved, so that life-cycle of a document is more easily interpreted. [8234]
- When searching by 'Operation', the user can now select from a drop-down list rather than having to manually type the values in. [8236]
- When searching by 'Submission Type', the user can now select from a drop-down list rather than having to manually type the values in. [8238]
- The order of the documents displayed in the Cumulative view has been made consistent across different regions. [8290]
- A new option is added to the Save as New feature. When “Convert Append to New” is selected all Append leaves will be converted to New, otherwise they will remain as Append. [8301]
- For submissions that use multiple DTD's across sequences, the sequential view now displays the element name corresponding to the DTD used to create the sequence. The current and cumulative views always use the section nodes from the most recent DTD. [8303]
- Improvements have been made to the printed TOC document, including improved flexibility in content and positioning of Header and Footer information and an optional column heading for 'Description' and 'Filename'. [8365]

## 4 Resolved Defects

- For Japanese region only, when using the 'Save current view as new' feature, the MD5 checksum value in the index.xml, for <m1-administrative-information-and-prescribing-information> did not match the generated md5 value of jp-regional-index.xml. [8219]

- When the application was closed using the top right corner 'close button' (X), the status bar was not updating correctly. [8221]
- In the Properties screen of documents in higher sequences there was a duplication of xlink:type attributes. [8222]
- After performing the right click options 'Expand all' and then 'Collapse all' on the same module, both the submission and the module were highlighted for focus in the UI. [8224]
- When performing a search using the group "Search – CTD Sections (ICH XML)" and two or more values were selected with the option "All (and condition)", the results displayed were using the "Any (or condition)" instead of displaying the message "Search is complete. There are no results to display." [8233]
- For a 'Search in Leaf', searches on the 'ID' value were giving no result even for valid values. [8237]
- After performing 'Save Current view as new', an incorrect entry was created for any deleted leaf in both the index and regional xml files. [8246]
- There were 'refresh' issues when filtering based on country and discipline. [8253]
- Clicking on links or bookmarks with action 'Open a file' or 'Go to a page in another document' may have displayed an error message. [8258]
- When all modules were disabled in the Table of Contents and a user attempted to reload any submission, module contents were not displayed even though they appeared to be enabled. [8259]
- When a printed TOC was created for Japanese applications, the TOC entries were showing junk characters. [8260]
- When Initial view of the PDF document was set to 'Bookmarks Panel and Page', the Bookmarks panel was not being displayed along with the Page in the Content panel of VUE. [8263]
- For study files in current view, the latest information was not showing in the Properties Screen. [8267]
- After 'Save Current view as New' was performed for Japanese submissions, when documents with operation append were clicked the application was not responding. [8271]
- The order of options on the File Menu and Tool Bar was not consistent. [8275]
- The status bar did not display the 'Country' field when the screen resolution was set to 1024 by 768. [8289]
- An error message was not displayed when the user right-clicked on offline documents window and tried to delete files that were in use. [8297]
- The 'Document Cross Reference Details' in the Content Viewer did not include all the entries if the operation of the referenced document was set to 'Delete' [8298]
- An Unhandled exception was thrown when multiple attributes were selected and the user clicked on 'Clear All'. [8302]

- When sorting on multiple column headers of the 'Search Results' window, the application froze in Windows 7. [8302]
- Printed TOC's created for Swissmedic submissions contained 'junk' characters. [8304]
- The Swissmedic submission was incorrectly showing the label 'Submission Type' instead of 'Application Type' under the Regional Administrative Information window. [8323]
- The registration information was not being gathered correctly from non-english operating systems. [8350]
- In Japanese submissions the life cycle panel was not displaying information for documents where the operation was Append, Replace or Delete. [8837]
- When viewing a SwissMedic submission the leaves under 1.2.2 were not displayed in the correct order. [8850]
- The regional administrative information was not displaying 2 byte Japanese characters. [8968]

### 5.2 Upgrade Details

1. Uninstall Datafarm VUE v1.0 by accessing the Add or Remove Programs option from the Control Panel.

2. Follow the installation instructions as listed below in the ‘New Installation Details’ section to install Datafarm VUE v1.1

### 5.3 New Installation Details

1. Double-click on the *Datafarm VUE.exe* file.
2. Select the required language for the installation.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions in the Datafarm VUE Setup screens, clicking Next whenever you are ready to proceed to the next step. When the process is complete, a message displays indicating that Datafarm VUE is successfully installed.

### 5.4 Registration Details (*Not applicable for existing customers*)

1. Double-click on the *Datafarm VUE* icon from the desktop or select *Datafarm VUE* from Start > Programs > Datafarm eCTD Apps. The Product Registration screen appears.
2. Click on the Register button and complete the required information in the License Registration window.
3. Select the License Type and accept the License agreement.
4. If you have Microsoft Outlook, select the Email button and send the License request to [support@datafarminc.com](mailto:support@datafarminc.com).

5. Close the License Registration window.

***Datafarm will send you the license.xml file. Once the file is received extract the file from e-mail to your desktop or a folder on your local drive and complete the activation using the steps below.***

1. Double-click on the *Datafarm VUE* icon from the desktop or select *Datafarm VUE* from Start > Programs > Datafarm eCTD Apps. Product Registration screen appears.
2. Click on the Activate button and open the License.xml received from Datafarm technical support.

- For JP submissions the appended document was not showing under parent node in the sequential view for m2-m5. [8270]

- An unknown file type icon is displayed in the current, cumulative and sequence views for .csv, .css, and .xsd files. [9170]
- Search that include a filter on galenic form will display results for all galenic forms. [9183]
- When IE (Internet Explorer) version is "8.0.6001.18702", External links in PDF document will not open. [9318]
- Datafarm VUE License tool doesn't create valid license on Windows-2000. [9319]
